What is condition and why it is important? Using real world examples, we will demonstrate how you can reduce the time taken to produce a programme of work across your Academy or MAT by 85%. You will learn how you can assess and prioritise across your MAT based on need. During this session you will see how condition surveys transformed into insightful and useful charts and discuss what should happen with your data. Condition is a means to an end, i.e. identifying where best to invest your capital. We will discuss and demonstrate how investment leads to a reduction in urgent backlog. We will also discuss how best to record and manage capital funds and how to effectively report on their allocation. We will discuss different types of projects such as onboarding of a new Academy or building a free School, and how best to manage these.
